

**Training starts annually at the beginning of the following months:
March, April, August, September, October and November**

Training as a carer (m/f/d)

Has caring always been your thing? Would you like to choose a career that is meaningful and will give you the feeling that you are needed every day? Then training as a carer could be just the thing for you.

Duration of training

3 years

If you have successfully completed training in assistant and helper occupations in the care sector, the duration of training can be shortened following an examination.

Minimum requirements

One of the following qualifications is required by law:

- an intermediate school leaving certificate such as Fachoberschulreife (FOR) or higher,
- ten years of general school education with a secondary general school certificate Grade 10,
- a nine-year secondary general school leaving certificate in conjunction with a recognised a recognised one-year nursing assistant training course,
- another two-year completed vocational training programme.

Important to know:

3 months before the start of training, an extended certificate of good conduct (NE) free of entries and a medical certificate to practise the profession must be submitted.

You will not only spend the three-year vocational training programme in our company, but will also get to know other areas of care. This makes this apprenticeship particularly varied.

Please also apply to the neighbouring vocational schools for a training place. This is required for your training with us. Training in nursing also differs from other training occupations where the company enrolls trainees at a vocational school.

Additional requirements for foreign applicants:

- Proof of German language skills at level B1 of the Common European Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) is required. This must not be older than 1 year if a visa is required.
- If a visa is required, you must be under the age of 35.

You must apply for a visa in person at the relevant German embassy in your home country. The accelerated skilled labour procedure must go through us as the employer, as we liaise directly with the Cologne district government. This will result in non-refundable costs for you. To be on the safe side, find out about the amount of these costs in advance.

What you can expect from us:

Talpflege GmbH has high quality standards. We therefore offer all employees the opportunity to continuously develop their skills and qualifications. We have been an outpatient care service* in Wuppertal since 2018. In addition to the outpatient care service, we operate three dementia residential communities in Wuppertal-Elberfeld and three dementia residential communities in Wuppertal-Ronsdorf. With more than 100 employees today, we have grown rapidly. When so many people work together, things can sometimes go wrong. But we are working to improve – for our employees and for our patients.
